¹When Jesus rode into Jerusalem he came in amongst shouts familiar to all who have attended a Catholic Mass: **“HOSANNA IN THE HIGHEST, BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD.”**

²Even though it is quite famous today, the *Last Supper* painting by **LEONARDO DA VINCI** isn't all that accurate.

³The first Jewish Passover was eaten **1,300** years before the time of Christ and it was eaten standing up with staff in hand as the Hebrews were prepared to escape from Egypt. Their lives had been spared by painting the **BLOOD OF THE LAMB** on the doorframes of their homes... But what about the meat? They **ATE** it.

⁴When Jesus broke the bread he clearly said, **“THIS IS MY BODY”**, not ‘This represents or symbolizes my body’.

⁵At the beginning of time mankind brought sin and death into the world when they gave into Satan's temptation in the Garden of **EDEN** Now Jesus begins the conquering of sin and death when he successfully fights against Satan's temptations in another garden, the Garden of **GETHSEMANE**.

⁶During the agony in the garden, Jesus prays, “Father, if possible, take this cup away from me. But **NOT MY WILL, BUT YOURS BE DONE”**.

⁷It was a Jewish law that the Passover lamb had to be without blemish and faultless. It had to be a perfect little lamb. And as the priests were examining the **LAMBS**, Pilate was examining **JESUS**. And as the priests certified that the lambs were without blemish, Pilate said of Jesus, **“I FIND NO FAULT IN HIM”**.

⁸The flogging (aka scourging) of Jesus fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah 53:5: “He was wounded for our transgressions and by his **STRIPES** we are **HEALED”**.

⁹Although you could die from thirst, shock, loss of blood, and heart failure, the most common cause of death from crucifixion was **ASPHYXIATION** (aka suffocation).

¹⁰The physical pain was probably the least of our Lord's agony. We will never comprehend the **SPIRITUAL** and psychological suffering that he experienced... The holy Son of God took upon himself all the vile **SINS** of the world. He became sin for us.”
