1. Explain C.S. Lewis' Trilemma.

a. Answer:

- i. The Trilemma refers to C.S. Lewis' explanation of how Jesus CANNOT be seen as just a good, moral teacher (like Buddha, Confucius, etc.).
- ii. C.S. Lewis shows that Jesus must either be the Lord (God), a liar (he knew he wasn't God), or a lunatic (he thought he was God).
- iii. If Jesus *was*, in fact, God, then we have two choices: Follow him or reject him.
