

MAY CROWNING



1. Each year two 8th grade students (one girl, one boy) are voted on by their peers to represent St. Mary and St. Joseph at the May Crowning ceremony.

2. Students are asked to vote for one girl and one boy that they believe best represents the holy virtues lived out by St. Mary and St. Joseph.

3. Teachers do not vote. Since you experience one another in more situations (around classmates, around adults, in school, out of school, online, etc.) we assume that you know one another better and can therefore cast a more accurate vote.

4. While it is fun to see which two students end up representing St. Mary and St. Joseph, please remember that these are the two students who received the most votes, but not ALL the votes. Every year a number of different 8th graders are nominated by their classmates, but for the sake of our upcoming May Crowning ceremony, only the top 2 vote getters will be announced.

5. Voting should be done with utmost maturity and honest consideration for those who have tried their best to be saintly day-in and day-out.

6. Voting should NOT be based on popularity, friendship ties, any kind of “campaigning” done by students, or as a way to be funny.

7. Please do not tell anyone who you voted for until after each 8th grade class has had a chance to vote. Thank you!
